Products to be used:

YATES BAYTHROID LAWN GRUB AND GARDEN INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 55764)
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 12.5 g/L CYFLUTHRIN as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Potted plants, containerised plants and bagged root-balled plants	Red Imported Fire Ant (<i>Solenopsis invicta</i>)	Apply 16ml product / 10 L water as a pot drench.
	Tropical Fire Ant (<i>Solenopsis geminata</i>)	Apply ONLY as a drench. DO NOT dip pots into prepared dip/bath solution.

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply once only prior to movement.
- To minimise operator exposure to the product, DO NOT handle treated pots for 48 hours post treatment.
- Move pots within the next 24 hours (i.e. between 48-72 hrs. following application) to maintain the potency of the product to fire ants.
- Always use rubber gloves when handling pots.

Jurisdiction:

QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
